High School Admissions Requirements Will Change This Fall

Chicago Public Schools recently announced that all 7th graders will NOT be taking their Spring NWEA MAP test. The NWEA MAP test will NOT be used to determine admission into high school.

CPS will use 7th grade final grades and the CPS High School Admissions Test to determine admission into high school. Starting in the fall of 2021, all 8th graders will be taking the CPS High School Admissions test during their school day to promote equal access to testing for all CPS students.
