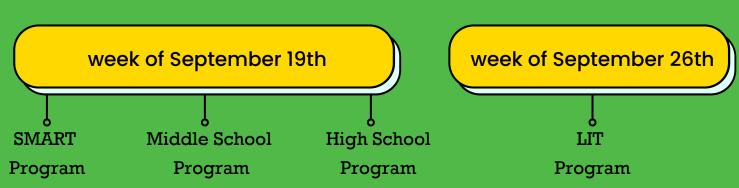

Digital
